19th FIT Charity Run Held Successfully

On December 10, 2023, the 19th FIT Charity Run 2023 was held at Meiji Jingu Gaien. The total amount of donations this year amounted to 53,662,400 yen, and the cumulative amount of donations of FIT For Charity Run will reach 1 billion yen.

Over 4,500 people from 92 financial institutions both domestically and internationally participated in the FIT For Charity Run this year. The total amount of sponsorship fee from 52 financial service-related companies who support the event's causes, proceeds from the sale of event T-shirts and charity lottery tickets on the day, participation fees, and donations from participating companies and participants amounted to 53,662,400 yen. The amount remaining after deducting expenses from this donation will be evenly donated to the following eight organizations.
